Dear Parents/Guardians.

After the popularity shown for our 2019 Ski trip to North America we are looking to repeat this for 2020. The trip will give your daughter/son the chance to learn/develop a new skill as well as develop their ability to work in a team, to help others and to be responsible for themselves and their kit! In addition to skiing, we will have an opportunity to spend a day at Maligne Canyon in the Rockies. If you would like your daughter/son to take part, please complete the attached form and return to us by Tues 27th Nov. If your daughter/son is offered a place on the trip and you accept it, the non-refundable deposit (£250) will need to be paid via ParentPay by Dec 6th. Details will be emailed out. If you wish to split this payment we can accept £150 by Dec 6th and a further £100 by Wed 9th Jan. Future payments will need to be made at regular intervals prior to departure (£250 by Wed 20th Feb 2019, £250 by Wed 1st May, £250 by Wed 26th Jun, £250 by Wed 25th Sept and a final payment of £185/£263 by Wed 27th Nov). The additional £78 is applicable for any students aged 16+ on the date of departure. It represents the APD (Air Passenger Duty tax).

Our trip is based on an initial allocation of 40 places. If by Tues 27th Nov 2018 demand exceeds supply, places will be allocated firstly to pupils in Y12/13 (academic year 2019/2020), then through a ballot for pupils in Y10/11 (academic year 2019/2020). Students in the current Y9 who missed out on a place on the 2019 trip will be prioritised in the ballot for the Y10/11. Any remaining places will be balloted for pupils in Y9 (academic year 2019/2020). If however, there is sufficient demand we will endeavour to increase the number of places.

Paperwork will be returned for any students not accepted on to the trip.

Pupils will only be accepted onto this trip if they have a good behavioural record at school and continue to have so in the run up to the trip. Pupils need to ensure that their pathways records are of a high standard and pupils will forfeit their place (and their deposit) if we consider their behaviour and attitude to learning in school to be unsatisfactory.

All students must be attending The Maelor School in order to go on the trip. Deposits received after Dec 6th 2018 will only be accepted if places are available.
